Project Overview:

TASK: You are to create a poster that represents Earth as an Artform.

AUDIENCE: Other students

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use the above websites to view different images taken from satellites.
- 2. Select an image.
- 3. Copy the image to a word document. The size of the image must cover 1/4th of the sheet of paper.
- 4. Next to the image, insert a map, which shows the location of the landform you selected.
- 5. Below the image and map, type a descriptive paragraph that must include the following:
 - a. Type of landform (Atoll, Bay, Canyon, Crater, Fjord, Glacier, Lagoon, Moraine, Oxbow lake, River, Volcano, etc.)
 - b. Size of the landform
 - c. Satellite that took the image
 - d. Type of climate (temperature and rainfall) for this area
 - e. Describe any vegetative or animal life forms native to the area.
 - f. Type of rock common to this area
 - g. Describe any water features found in the area
 - h. Describe any other important or interesting facts
- 6. Print out your final project. If you are printing out your project in black and white, the image must be clear and features distinguishable.
